


Metrotile Shingle

The unique alternative to traditional shingle and slate.

Design

The Metrotile Shingle profile is designed to get the same appearance as the traditional slates, with the additional benefits of steel roofing.

Metrotile Shingle is a stone-coated panel pressed from a high grade of Aluzinc® coated or equivalent steel and is available in a wide selection of colours to enhance any exterior colour scheme.

Installation

The tiling battens for installing the shingle tiles have to be positioned with a 250 mm spacing measured from the front batten of each batten up to the ridge.

Start at the bottom right hand side and work from right to left. Use 4 nails or screws to fix each shingle tile to the roof batten. If possible, use the cut-off from the previous to start the next course. Hook nose of upper tile into lip of tile below ensuring a tight fit. Continue with each successive course up.

At the upper course, cut the tiles to suit the ridge and attach a batten on top of the Shingle tile. Finally fix the ridge to the batten.
